



1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
2. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
3. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

2. The School will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch, which is not affiliated.
3. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
4. The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
5. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
6. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.

7. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
8. The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required
9. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
10. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
11. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
12. **The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider.**
13. **The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act -1995'.**
14. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
15. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.
16. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
17. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
18. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
19. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is **830311**. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
20. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws/Rules of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in the joint names.
21. **Annual fee of Rs. 4500/- @ Rs.1500/- per annum for three years (01.04.2009 to 31.03.2012)** be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.)
22. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'on online' through www.cbseaff.nic.in with the prescribed fee of **Rs. 12,500/-** and other essential documents before 30th June of the preceding year before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation.
23. The school has been granted affiliation upto Secondary level w.e.f. 01.04.2009 accordingly it has become eligible to open CBSE pattern classes IX from the session 2009-10 and 1st Batch of class X of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in the year 2011.



Conditions for which compliance to be submitted within three months of issue of sanction letter:-

1. Running starting of Class IX/X & XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level/Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorized classes and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. Non-submission of application for extension of provisional affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to the year by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws.

4. 

8. The school should scrupulously observe prescription from the Municipal Authority/District Collectorate/Transport Department regarding drinking water, fire safety and transport precautions in the school. A certificate from the Municipal/Fire/transport Authority regarding sanitary conditions, water/fire/transport safety should be submitted every five years as per Rule 8.5 of Affiliation Bye Laws and shall follow Rule no. 3.3(vii) and Rule 23(xi) in this regard.
9. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
10. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
11. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.
12. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. 13. The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
14. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
15. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
16. 19. As per rule no. 19.1 (ii).a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
20. Teachers are to be made educated regarding corporal punishment & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
21. School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
22. **Admission to the school** is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
23. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaska and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
24. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
25. **Pay and allowances** to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government/Govt. of India. Further, **Salary and Service conditions** of staff should be provided in accordance with Rule no. 3.3 (v) and Rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.
26. As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/State/ Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, postal address and e-mail, telephone numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, details of teachers, number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye-Laws and upload the same on the website before 15th September of every year. 27. Continuous **sponsoring of students at Board examination** is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv), Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be.
28. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.



29. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
30. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the '**Persons with Disabilities Act 1995**'.
31. **School infrastructure and teachers for examinations** conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
32. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least **one week training programme** for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
33. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
34. Strict adherence to the provisions of **Wild Life Protection Act** while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
35. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books published by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of **private publishers**. The contents must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If prescribed books found having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.
36. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
37. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV).
38. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
39. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
40. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
41. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in & www.cbse.nic.in for updates.
42. In case of established violation of the provisions contained in Affiliation/Examination Bye laws of the Board, the school shall be liable for disaffiliation as per Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye laws.



43. The school shall enter into an agreement with the Board detailing the terms and conditions for grant of affiliation, which will be binding on both the parties.

44. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

- The school is required to appoint Special Educator as per rule 13 (11) of Affiliation Byelaws of the Board and as mentioned in Board's circular dated 25.06.2015.
- The school should improve its financial status and resources for growth and sustenance of the institution.
- The school is required to furnish a Fire Safety Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- The school should have trained and qualified teaching staff and ii) the school will pay the pay scale and allowances which should at least be at par with corresponding categories of teachers employed in government institutions of the State Govt. or as per scale prescribed in 6th Central Pay Commission of Govt. of India in respect of its teachers and will make the payment through ECS mode with proper deduction of EPF and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The same can be checked and verified by the Board at any time.

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The Composite science lab set up temporarily on tables. There are no work stations, and safety features like exhaust fan, fire extinguisher. A gas cylinder is seen on the floor which is hazardous for the students. The school should upgrade the lab in the light of the SoPs issued by the board vide circular no. 11 dated 04.10.2022 and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
2	The school should shift the Maths lab to a bigger room according to the size prescribed in the Affiliation bye laws and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on SARAS portal.
3	The school should shift the Computer lab to a bigger room according to the size prescribed in the Affiliation bye laws and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on SARAS portal.
4	The Library is 480 sq. ft which is not as per Affiliation Bye laws. The school should shift the library to a bigger room according to the size prescribed in the Affiliation bye laws and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on SARAS portal.
5	The school should provide proper drinking water for the students and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
6	The school should upgrade the indoor/ outdoor sports facilities as per the SoPs issued by the board and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on SARAS portal.
7	The school should construct a ramp or lift to access upper floor for CWSN students as per RPwD act 2016 submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on SARAS portal.
8	One CWSN toilet shown is very small as existing cubicle has been converted to CWSN toilets which is not navigable by wheel chair users/walkers. The school should construct CWSN toilets separately for boys and girls on every floor as prescribed in RPwD Act 2016 and Circular no. 5 dated 06.03.2023 issued by the board and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on SARAS portal.

9	The school should ensure training of teachers with CoE Bengaluru and submit the compliance within 3 months.
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Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School is required to apply on online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school is required to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
8. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

“The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
